Since my little one is due in December (practically the heart of winter), I am excited to feature Dots on Tots in my holiday gift guide. These little hats are adorable as well as perfect to keep babies and toddlers warm when out in the cold.



Small children don't understand that they cannot go outside and play during the Winter season. They will usually beg to go out and play in the snow (if you are lucky enough to get some) or just kick through the leaves. My 3 year old does this on an almost-daily basis, and it's hard to tell him no. So instead, we bundle him up and let him go out for 10-15 minutes.

Our kid is satisfied and we are happy that he's no longer whining. Younger babies don't really need to be out in the cold, but it is inevitable if you need to get them to the daycare, doctor's office, or anywhere else you need to go. Dots on Tots is the

perfect solution to keep the cold off your little ones.

I love that the Dots on Tots Ear Protection hat features ear flaps to protect my baby from the wind and chill. So many of the cute hats you see for kids do not fit right to be pulled over the ears. You would then need to buy them ear muffs or another hat for when they are going outside. They are easy to put on, securing with velcro rather than a snap. Snaps are so difficult to work with a mobile baby!



The Ear Protection hat that I received comes in three different sizes. I was sent the Small for my pending arrival. Dots on Tots also gives the option of an ear protection hat that shields the wearer's ears from up to 50% of the noise around them. This would be perfect for those that don't care for loud crowds or other locations.

All hats are 100% organic, eco-friendly and made in the USA. I really like this, because skin allergies and other conditions run in my family. Our three year old doesn't have any problems other than slightly dry skin, but we have no idea what baby #2 will be like!
